The Sherwood Seminar will be moving their meetings to Lowe's Wharf for the winter months. Join us on February 21st. Our lands and waters are among the most scenic in the world. But, there is a problem just out of sight and right beneath our feet. Septic systems throughout our area are failing and contaminating our precious natural resources. What to do is a challenging, perplexing, expensive and controversial issue. To help us understand the problem and proposed solutions, County Engineer Ray Clarke has agreed to share his knowledge. The issue is under active consideration as part of the County's comprehensive zoning revisions, which includes amending the Country's Comprehensive Water and Sewer Plan. What's being contemplated is extending sewer service to the western villages including Claiborne and Sherwood. And, our speaker is in charge of that planning process. 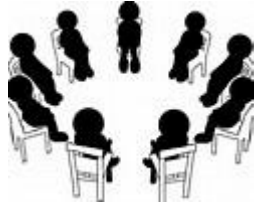

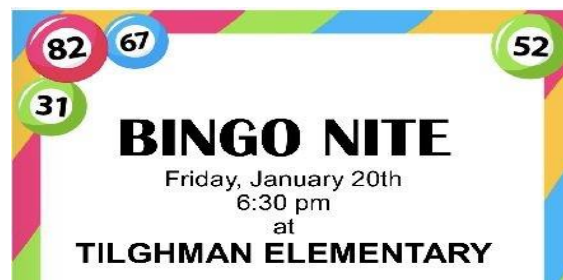
