### **The Sheep Trail**

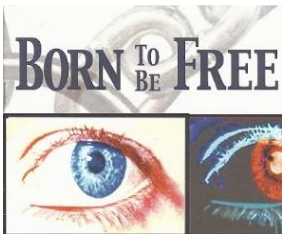
