

### **Edna Lockwood Returns to Tilghman for Heritage Tour, July 19-21**

#### **Docking at Phillips Wharf Environmental Center**

Built in 1889 by John B. Harrison on Tilghman Island for Daniel W. Haddaway, *Edna Lockwood* dredged for oysters on the Chesapeake Bay through winter, and carried freight after the dredging season ended. Recognized as the last working oyster boat of her kind, Edna Lockwood was declared a National Historic Landmark in 1994. CBMM staff members will offer free deck tours, giving guests a chance to explore the bug-eye while docked.



Must be able to carry a 32 oz. cooler. Must be at least 6 feet in length. Must be man powered or sail. Raft must be approved before the race. Must be 18 to participate. Not responsible for accidents or injuries on your own boat.
