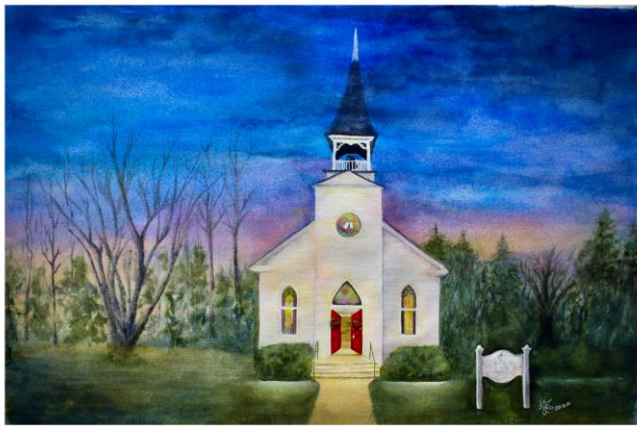

Did you know that...

On March 19, 1904, the Eastern Gazette reported that a **“destructive fire visited Tilghman Island”** destroying Avalon Packing Co., Howeth Packing Co., Covington Brothers Packing Co. and a large grocery store. It was all over in an hour as high winds drove the flames. Losses amounted to \$30,000 (about \$2M today). **“This is a severe blow to the hustling community. The determined spirit of all is shown when it is stated that already preparations are being made to rebuild.”**

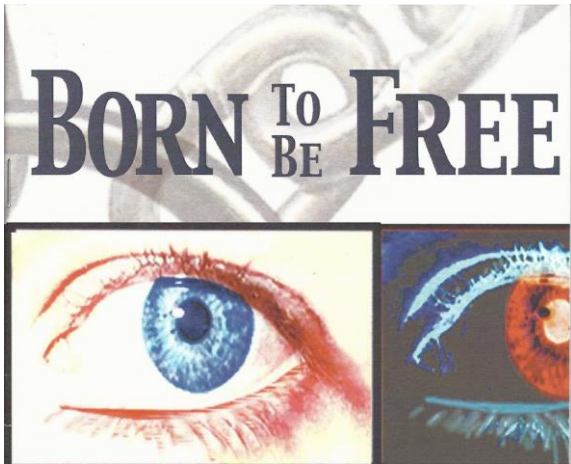

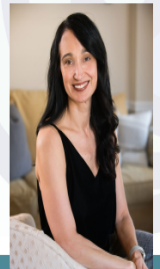
