- · Avalon Island was originally built in 1893 as a 1200-foot steamboat pier
- · Shucking houses were built almost immediately on pilings along side the pier - their discarded oyster shells "grew" the island
- Multiple businesses and a Post Office were established on the island
- The Tilghman Packing Co. shipped fresh, frozen and canned fish, crabs, oysters, fruits and vegetables from the island until 1975
- Today, 130 years later, Avalon Island is a marina & clubhouse for community residents
