#### Did you know that ...

- Tilghman Island has a long history of hospitality.
- 1892 saw the first steamboat wharf in service to bring visitors from Baltimore and Washington.



- Residents welcomed guests and summer boarders to supplemented their income.
- By 1900 purpose built boarding houses were being constructed for island guests.
- Roads replaced ferries in the 1920s allowing the hospitality industry on Tilghman to grow.
- Island guests would sport fish, hunt, boat, and enjoy the natural beauty and amenities of Tilghman Island (as they still do today!)
