Harrison in Tilghman, Maryland, She is 35 feet 6 inches (10.82 m) long with a beam of 8 feet 6 inches (2.59 m), and built of five logs. She is one of the last 22 surviving traditional Chesapeake Bay racing log canoes that carry on a tradition of racing on the Eastern Shore of Maryland which has existed since the 1840s. 

- Tall, skinny pictures and subjects are not as useful. Square or horizontally rectangular photos work better – pictures shaped like a TV screen. 'Landscape' is better than 'portrait'. 8 X 10 works well.
- Pictures of people and boats are especially helpful.
- Children and pets are also really good.
- Sunrises and sunsets come in by the dozens, so the competition in that area makes it tougher to get into the calendar.
- Fall and winter are useful because we don't get as many of those.
- Basically, the more 'Tilghman' a photo is, the more helpful it is. Tilghman people, boats, events, landmarks and buildings
- Phone pictures are OK. The bigger, the better.
- Pictures work better sent as attachments to an email.
- Please don't compress the photos or edit them.
- The photo deadline is September 1st.
