That Tilghman Island was called "Great Choptank Island" when originally granted to Seth Foster in 1659. In 1741 Matthew Tilghman inherited the island and it became known as Tilghman Island after his family farmed it for ~100 years. By 1849 the Tilghmans sold out and settlement began as the fishing industry grew.

### Here are some basic guidelines:

- Tall, skinny pictures and subjects are not as useful. Square or horizontally rectangular photos work better – pictures shaped like a TV screen. 'Landscape' is better than 'portrait'. 8 X 10 works well.
- Pictures of people and boats are especially helpful.
- Children and pets are also really good.
- Sunrises and sunsets come in by the dozens, so the competition in that area makes it tougher to get into the calendar.
- Fall and winter are useful because we don't get as many of those.
- Basically, the more 'Tilghman' a photo is, the more helpful it is. Tilghman people, boats, events, landmarks and buildings
- Phone pictures are OK. The bigger, the better.
- Pictures work better sent as attachments to an email.
- Please don't compress the photos or edit them.
- The photo deadline is September 1st.
