

### Tilghman Watermen's Museum Scholarship

#### Value of Award

The recipient that is honored with this scholarship will receive \$1,000.00 awarded to the student in June.

### **Application**

A student who wishes to be considered can fill out the application and mail with the supporting documents to the attention of the TWM Scholarship Committee PO Box 344, Tilghman, Maryland 21671 and must be postmarked no later than April 1 of the year for which the student is asking to be considered.

All applicants must use the official Tilghman Watermen's Museum Scholarship Form.

The following supporting documents must be submitted with the application form:

- Copy of the student's current high school transcript
- Copy of acceptance letter from an accredited institution of higher learning.
- One page letter of recommendation from a non-family member addressing the student's character.
- An essay by the applicant. The essay should address why you want to attend a college or training school and what are the experiences that led you to this decision.

B uilt in 1891 by a group of Trustees in the nearby Villages of Fairbank and Barneck, St. John's Chapel (SJC) has roots extending back over 125 years.

It was founded as a small Methodist congregation at the southern end of Tilghman's Island. It served all residents of the Island, but particularly those residing in the villages of Fairbank and Bar Neck. It remained active until the

Friends of St. John's Chapel was formed to maintain and preserve the historic Chapel, grounds, and cemetery.

Today, the Chapel is once again active. In addition to the non-denominational Sunday morning service, SJC hosts traditional Homecoming, Christmas Eve, and Easter Sunrise services annually as well as support group and other meetings to benefit the community.

St. John's is maintained by a dedicated group of Trustees and volunteers who want to keep SJC open so that future generations of Tilghman Islanders and the many tourists and visitors who come to our beautiful Island will have a place to gather.

oyce Cummings Hogan, daughter of Gorman "Sam" and Dorothy Cummings, was born in Talbot County, spent her early years in Fairbank, and graduated from Tilghman Elementary and Easton High Schools.

She earned a Bachelor's degree from Towson State University and Master's and Doctorate degrees from the University of Maryland College Park.



n accomplished scientist, scholar, An accomplished series researcher, teacher, mentor, and athlete, Dr. Hogan was a:

- leading authority on human performance, and a pioneer in developing job-related hiring procedures for physically demanding jobs, opening doors for many people who had been unlawfully excluded from jobs such as police officer, firefighter, and oil refinery worker;
- accomplished academic and scholar, first as an Adjunct Assistant Professor of Psychology at the John's Hopkins University in Baltimore and then a Professor of Psychology at the University of Tulsa where she helped develop a Ph.D. program in Industrial-Organizational Psychology;

- exceptional scientist-practitioner, named a Fellow of two divisions of the American Psychological Association;
- prolific author of technical reports, articles, and book chapters, including publishing in top-tier professional journals such as the Journal of Applied Psychology and American Psychologist;



- editor of Human Performance, which publishes research investigating the nature and role of performance in the workplace;
- respected mentor who shared freely her life-long passion for learning and excellence and provided her students with many opportunities to participate in innovative research


- and associated professional activities such as publishing articles and making presentations;
- competitive athlete and nationallyranked squash player;
- coach of women's athletic teams at the high school and college levels in numerous sports, and the first Director of Women's Athletics at the Johns Hopkins University; and
- co-founder of a global consulting firm dedicated to improving individual and organizational performance through the use of valid assessments.



r. Hogan was committed to intellectual rigor, integrity, and the pursuit of excellence. A fierce advocate for fairness and social justice for more than three decades, she was passionate about equal opportunity for all.

She was also a philanthropist who provided vital support to St. John's Chapel for many years.
