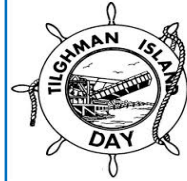

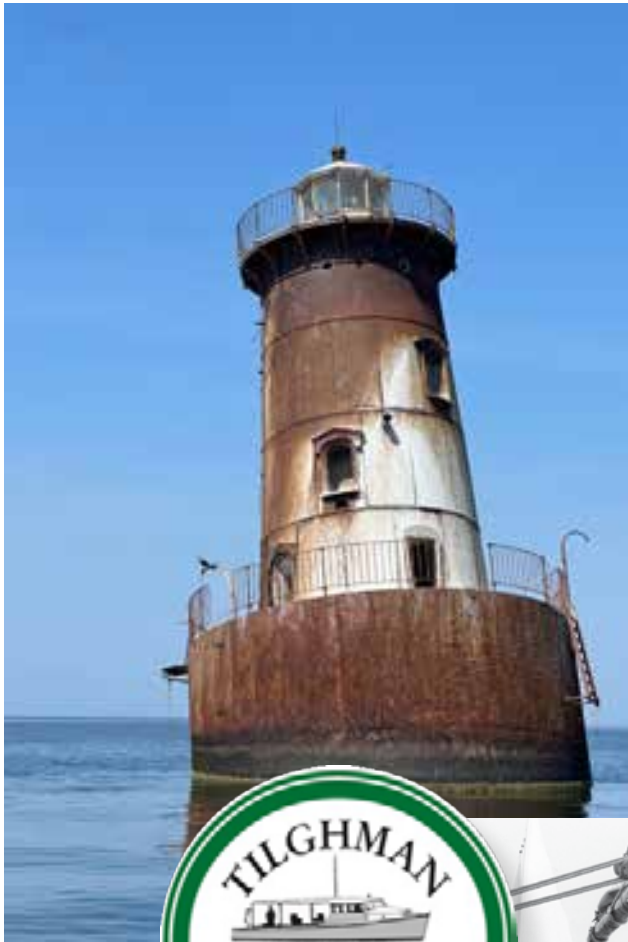

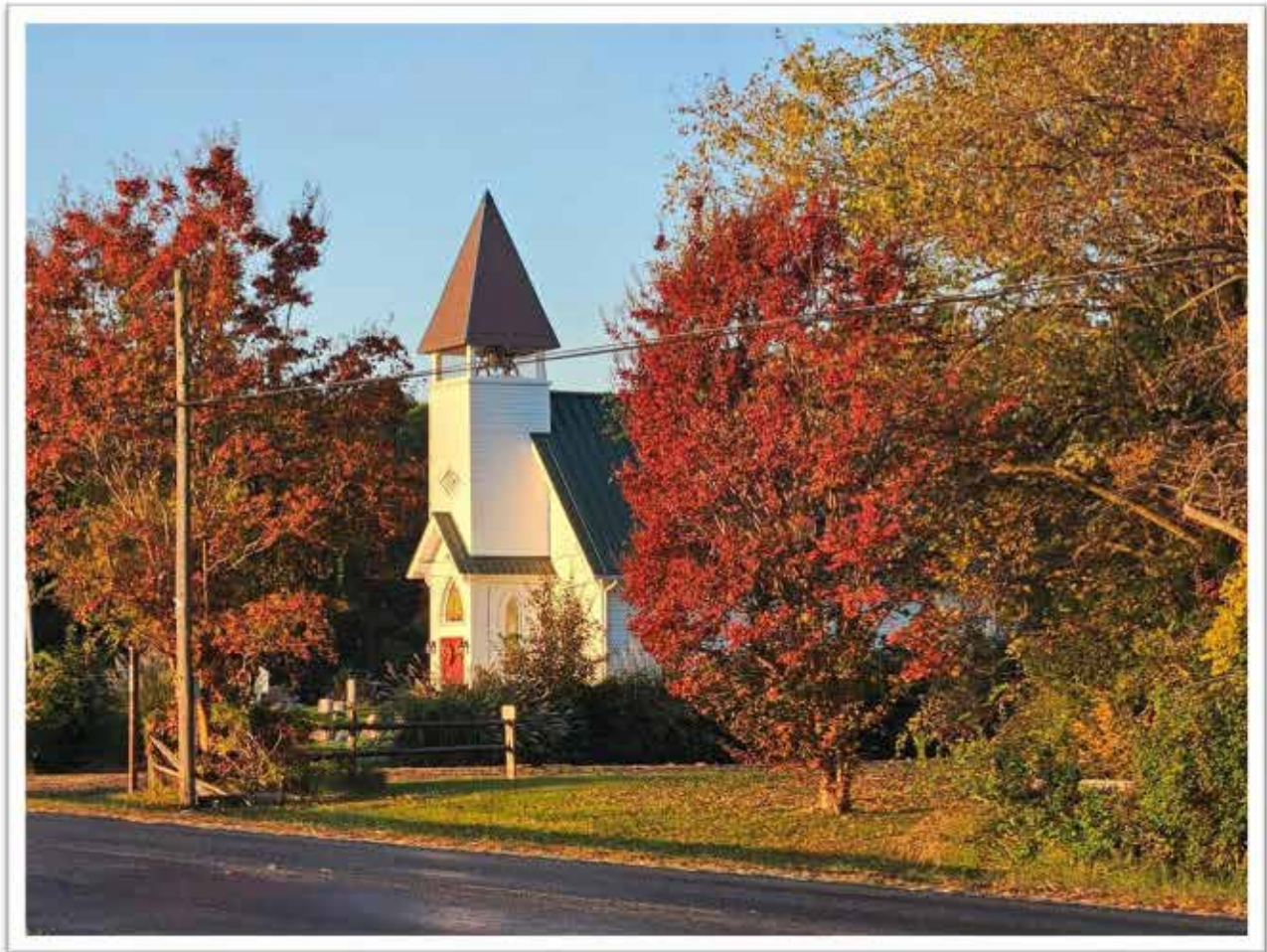

OLD TESTAMENT BIBLE STUDY

Why is it important to study a book that was written thousands of years ago? Beginning the week of September 8th, join us for a 12-week study of the Old Testament. We will explore the Hebrew Bible, Creation, the Patriarchs, the Sinai Covenant, and Kings and Prophets. We will endeavor to answer how the Old Testament relates to history and to our life today.

This free study will be held at St. John's Chapel on Tuesday nights at 6:00 PM and is open to everyone. It will also be taught Wednesday mornings at 10:00 AM at the Ladies Bible Study held at 6101 Sunset Lane. By request, Linda King will be the teacher. Before moving to Tilghman, she taught classes in conjunction with the Oral Roberts University Bible Institute program. She has a Master's Degree from Liberty Theological Seminary, and has been licensed as a minister since 1982.
